

**Scrip:** A form of money issued by a local government or private organization; any of various documents used as evidence that the holder or bearer is entitled to receive something.  
*Examples:* Vouchers, IOUs, arcade tokens, movie tickets, and gift cards.



Introducing St. John's exciting new fundraiser . . . **SCRIP**. The Scrip program combines two great things – shopping and supporting your school!

## Here's how Scrip works:

- You **place an order** for gift cards by 11:30 Monday morning. (Don't worry, it doesn't actually have to be a gift!) Orders will be taken twice each month during the school year.
- You **receive your cards** by the following Monday morning.
- You **shop**, using the cards as cash for the full amount you paid.
- The **school receives a rebate** of up to 15% of the card value!

Do you shop at Ace Hardware, Walmart, Family Fare, Dunham's, or Rite Aid? Eat at Subway or Applebee's? Place orders with Amazon? You could be earning cash for your school with each purchase!

**AND, here's something new... 50% of what you earn can be added to the tuition account of your choice!**

Order forms are available in the school office and at the local Lutheran churches. Payment is requested at the time of your order.

\* Are you **computery**? Cards can also be ordered online.

\* **Smartphone junkie**? Some Scrip can be purchased on your phone – no need to wait for a card!
